“PICK 4”

1. CREATION

Pursuant to the laws creating and governing the Kentucky Lottery Corporation, there is created a lottery Draw Game, hereinafter called “Pick 4,” and its wager types, which shall be conducted pursuant to these Rules and Regulation and KRS Chapter 154A, and shall continue until the President publicly announces a termination date.

2. GENERAL PROVISIONS

Pick 4 tickets are governed by these Game Rules and Regulations and the “Draw Game General Rules”, which are incorporated herein by reference in their entirety. **The Draw Game General Rules together with these Game Rules and Regulations govern all matters and claims relating to Pick 4 including tickets, transactions, drawings, prizes, and prize claims. These Rules contain the sole and exclusive remedy for such claims.** The purchase of “Pick 4” through the Kentucky Lottery Corporation’s website at kylottery.com (“iLottery”) is governed by the Rules for the iLottery Purchase of Draw Games and the iLottery Terms of Use, which are incorporated, by reference, in addition to these rules. The wager type options, wager amount options, maximum wager amount, and other features of the game may differ from retail or be limited on iLottery.

3. PICK 4 DEFINITIONS

The following words and terms shall have the following meaning unless otherwise indicated:

- (a) **Pick 4 Drawing** – A Draw Game Drawing which collectively refers to the process of randomly selecting, by computer, One (1) four-digit number from 0000 through 9999 which determines the Pick 4 Winning Number and which shall be used to determine winning Pick 4 plays.
- (b) **Pick 4 Game Ticket or Ticket** - A Pick 4 ticket, produced by a Retailer in an authorized manner, is a Draw Game Ticket and contains one (1) to five (5) separate plays (for tickets generated by

Play Slips) or one (1) to ten (10) separate plays (for tickets generated manually), drawing date(s), drawing time(s) (Midday, Evening or Both), the amount wagered and the validation serial number. A Pick 4 Ticket, if purchased through the KLC website at kylottery.com, is an iLottery Draw Game Ticket and means an electronic or virtual Ticket or play which conforms to the requirements of the Rules for the iLottery Purchase of Draw Games, the iLottery Terms of Use, and all applicable laws;

- (b) **Pick 4 Winning Number** – the Draw Game Winning Number which is the One (1) four-digit number from 0000 through 9999 randomly selected at each Pick 4 Drawing which shall be used to determine the winning Pick 4 plays contained on Tickets;
- (c) **Straight Wager** - A four-digit number from 0000 through 9999 designated to match in exact order the Pick 4 Winning Number;
- (d) **4-Way Box Wager** - A four-digit number with three duplicate digits (e.g., 1112), in any sequence;
- (e) **6-Way Box Wager** - A four-digit number with two sets of duplicate digits (e.g., 1212), in any sequence;
- (f) **12-Way Box Wager** - A four-digit number with two duplicate digits (e.g., 1123), in any sequence;
- (g) **24-Way Box Wager** - A four-digit number with no duplicate digits (e.g., 1234), in any sequence;
- (h) **Straight/Box Wager** - A one dollar (\$1.00) minimum wager in which places fifty cents (\$0.50) on a Box Wager and fifty cents (\$0.50) on a Straight Wager. Player collects on both the Straight Wager and Box Wager if number played is the winning number selected by the Lottery on a drawing day/time in exact order. The player collects on Box Wager, only, if the number played is the winning number selected by the Lottery on a drawing day/time in different order;

4. GENERAL DESCRIPTION AND HOW TO PLAY

The purpose of the "Pick 4" game shall be to determine winners from Ticket holders matching a four-digit number from 0000 through 9999, or a designated combination thereof, with the Pick 4 Winning Number randomly drawn at each Pick 4 Drawing.

5. TICKET PRICE AT RETAIL

Pick 4 Tickets may be purchased at an authorized Retailer for a minimum wager of fifty cents (0.50), or up to five dollars (\$5.00) per Play on a Play Slip, self-service terminal, or on iLottery, or up to ten dollars (\$10.00) per Play on the terminal, depending on the play type, or in multiples thereof in the case of an Advance or Multi-draw wager. Straight/Box wagers may be purchased for a minimum wager of one dollar (\$1.00). The President may authorize the sale of Pick 4 tickets at a discount for promotional purposes.

6. RESTRICTIONS FOR PICK 4 TICKETS PURCHASED AT RETAIL

- (a) Pick 4 tickets may be purchased for up to seven (7) consecutive drawings (known as "Multi-Draw"). Players may place multi-draw wagers for Midday draws, Evening draws, or Midday and Evening drawings (via the Both Option). If the Both Option is used in conjunction with Multi-Draw, a ticket will be generated for each consecutive Midday and Evening draw of the desired number of draws selected;
- (b) Pick 4 Tickets may also be purchased for future drawings (Monday - Sunday) up to six (6) days in advance (known as "Advanced Wager"). Advance wagers may be placed for a single-draw Midday drawing, a single-draw Evening drawing, and a single-draw Midday & Evening drawing (via Both option) in advance of the current day by using the Day of Week and DRAW TIME keys.
- (c) A Pick 4 Ticket purchased from a Retailer may be canceled on the same day the ticket was purchased, within one hour of the purchase, only prior to the appropriate draw break, and only from the Retailer from whom the ticket was purchased.

7. TIME OF CONDUCTING DRAWINGS

- (a) **Time of Drawing** - Pick 4 Drawings shall be held on a daily basis as determined by the President and publicly announced by the

Lottery. Pick 4 drawings shall be held twice per day, Monday through Sunday, at approximately 1:20 p.m. ET and 10:55 p.m. ET;

8. DETERMINATION OF PRIZE WINNERS, PRIZE LIABILITY LIMITS, AND PROBABILITY OF WINNING

- (a) Owners of Tickets and prizes awarded shall be determined in the following table:

<u>Type of Wager & Odds</u>	<u>Ticket Cost</u>	<u>Prize</u>
Straight Wager: Four digits in exact order (e.g., 1234) - 1 way to win Odds: 1:10,000	\$1.00	\$5,000
Box (4-Way) Wager: Four digits with a triplicate digit (e.g., 1112) - 4 ways to win Odds: 1:2,500	\$1.00	\$1,200
Box (6-Way) Wager: Four digits with two duplicate digits (e.g., 1122) - 6 ways to win Odds: 1:1,667	\$1.00	\$ 800
Box (12-Way) Wager: Four digits with one duplicate digit (e.g., 1123) - 12 ways to win Odds: 1:833	\$1.00	\$ 400
Box (24-Way) Wager: Four digits with no duplicate digits (e.g., 1234) - 24 ways to win Odds: 1:417	\$1.00	\$ 200

<u>Type of Wager & Odds</u>	<u>Ticket Cost</u>	<u>Prize</u>
Straight/Box Wager:		
Combines a fifty cent (\$0.50) Straight Wager with a fifty cent (\$0.50) Box Wager on the same bet. Select winning digits in exact order and collect on both Straight and Box; select winning digits in any order and collect on Box, only (\$1.00 minimum wager).		
Straight/Box (4-Way) Wager: Odds: 1:10,000 (Straight); 1:2,400 (Box)	\$1.00	\$3,100 (exact order) \$ 600 (any order)
Straight/Box (6-Way) Wager: Odds: 1:10,000 (Straight); 1:1,667 (Box)	\$1.00	\$2,900 (exact order) \$ 400 (any order)
Straight/Box (12-Way) Wager: Odds: 1:10,000 (Straight); 1:833 (Box)	\$1.00	\$2,700 (exact order) \$ 200 (any order)
Straight/Box (24-Way) Wager: Odds: 1:10,000 (Straight); 1:417 (Box)	\$1.00	\$2,600 (exact order) \$ 100 (any order)

- (b) Prizes shown in the chart are based on minimum wagers. Wagers less than or in excess of the minimum decrease or increase the prize won proportionately.
- (c) The number of Prize Categories and the allocation of prize money among the Prize Categories may be changed at the discretion of the President and Board of Directors. Such change shall be announced by public notice.

- (d) The KLC may from time to time establish a prize liability limit for sales of Pick 4 Tickets for any given Drawing without public notice, thereby cutting off sales of tickets for such drawing if the liability limit would be exceeded by the drawing of any particular numbers.

9. CLAIM PERIOD, CLAIMING PRIZES, DETERMINATION OF PRIZE WINNERS, VALIDATIONS AND ALL OTHER MATTERS.

All other matters and claims relating to this “Pick 4” Game, including but not limited to purchases, transactions, determination of prize winners, validation, and prize claims, are governed by Kentucky law and the official Draw Game General Rules, incorporated herein by reference. The purchase of “Pick 4” through the KLC’s website at kylottery.com (“iLottery”) is governed by the Rules for the iLottery Purchase of Draw Games and the iLottery Terms of Use, which are incorporated, by reference, in addition to these Rules. These Rules collectively contain the sole and exclusive remedy for any and all claims.
