Addendum to Gold Rush Second Chance Promotion Rules & Regulations

At this time, due to the coronavirus and the health and safety of our employees, the Kentucky Lottery is postponing all non-essential Lottery operations, including promotional drawings which require Kentucky Lottery personnel. Promotional drawings affected by this postponement will be held within 30 days of Kentucky's Governor lifting the state of emergency.

Item #2 in the Rules and Regulations for the Gold Rush Second Chance Promotion will be affected by this change.

Addendum II to Gold Rush Second Chance Promotion Rules and Regulations

Summary:

Effective Friday, June 12, 2020, in lieu of awarding a pack of tickets from the KLC, the prize for the Second Tier Prize winners will be nine hundred dollars (\$900) in cash, less all required withholdings and offsets, which players can use to purchase a pack of tickets at a KLC retailer. The reason for this change is that tickets cannot be mailed to winners and would require an in-person claim at the KLC corporate office. Due to the coronavirus and the health and safety of our players and employees, the KLC is reducing non-essential in-person promotional claims, when feasible, and awarding prizes that can be mailed. Therefore, the following amendment to the Rules and Regulations for the Gold Rush Second Chance Promotion approved on Monday, June 15, 2020 will be implemented.

Current Rule 3:

3. A winner may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - One (1) Grand Prize winner will receive fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) in cash.
 - Ten (10) Second Tier winners will each receive one (1) full pack (30 per pack) of \$30 Gold Rush tickets (#761) valued at \$900.00.

Amended Rule 3:

3. A winner may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - One (1) Grand Prize winner will receive fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) in cash.
 - Ten (10) Second Tier winners will each receive nine hundred dollars (\$900) in cash

Current Rule 31 to be eliminated:

31. Prize winners must claim their prize of a full pack of Scratch-off tickets in person. If the prize winner is not able to claim their prize of a full pack of Scratch-off tickets in person then the prize must be forfeited. Prize winners may claim their prize of a full pack of Scratch-off tickets at the Kentucky Lottery Corporation, 1011 West Main Street, Louisville, KY 40202. If a prize winner cannot make it to the Kentucky Lottery Corporation, the prize winner must notify the Marketing

Department in writing and an alternate pickup location may be mutually agreed upon. There is no cash option and full pack of Scratch-off tickets cannot be mailed.

*Original Rule 31 will be eliminated, and all rules numbers thereafter decreased by one.
