POWERBALL Xs & Os™ OFFICIAL GAME RULES
ADDENDUM

Section 1 Governing Rules

All matters and claims relating to this “Powerball Xs & Os™” Game, including but not limited to purchases, transactions, determination of prize winners, validation, and prize claims, are governed by this Addendum, Kentucky law, the individual Powerball Xs & Os Official Game Rules, and the General Draw Games Rules and Regulations, which are incorporated herein by reference (collectively, these “Rules”). The purchase of “Powerball Xs & Os” through the Kentucky Lottery Corporation’s website at kylottery.com (“iLottery”) and official KLC app is governed by the Fun Club Rewards Terms of Use, Rules for the iLottery Purchase of Draw Games, and the iLottery Terms of Use, which are incorporated herein by reference, in addition to these Rules. These Rules collectively contain the sole and exclusive remedy for any and all claims.

Section 2 Retailer Selling Bonus

Retailer selling bonuses for selling a jackpot prize winning ticket shall be one percent (1%) of the Powerball Xs & Os tickets sold in Kentucky for each drawing commencing with the first drawing occurring after the immediately prior jackpot prize ticket was sold up to and including the drawing in which the jackpot prize ticket in question was sold. However, the amount of the retailer selling bonus shall at no time exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000). In the event there are multiple prize-winning tickets for a single prize, each retailer selling bonus will be reduced in proportion to the number of winners.

Section 3 Selection of Teams on a Ticket

Players must manually select eight (8) teams from the matrix of thirty-two (32) available teams, or players must select Quick Pick to have the computer randomly select all eight (8) teams. If a player manually selects less than eight (8) teams, the ticket will be rejected, and no wager will be placed until all eight (8) teams have been manually selected or Quick Picked by the player.

Section 4 Limitation on Number of Tickets and Draws

A ticket purchased from a terminal at Retail cannot exceed \$250 and a ticket purchased from a vending machine at Retail cannot exceed \$150. The number of consecutive draws available for purchase (“multidraw”) for a ticket purchased from a Retailer using a paper playslip, an iLottery mobile app digital play slip, or for a ticket purchased from the Lottery’s website will be 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 10 and 13.

Section 5 Draw Break

Pools will close and draw break will occur at 9:00 PM. Eastern Time.

Section 6 Interpretation of Powerball Xs & Os Official Game Rules

The President of the Kentucky Lottery Corporation shall have the authority to interpret and apply, and if necessary, amend or modify the Powerball Xs & Os Official Game Rules in order to comply with the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and to implement sales of the Powerball Xs & Os Game.

Section 7 Internet Ticket Sales

All purchases on the KLC website are governed by the KLC's Rules for the iLottery Purchase of Draw Games, the iLottery Terms of Use, and the Powerball Xs & Os Official Game Rules. A Powerball Xs & Os iLottery Draw Game Ticket means an electronic or virtual ticket or play, and is purchased only through the KLC's website or the official KLC mobile app. The purchase of an iLottery Draw Game Ticket is a "ticketless transaction" under the Powerball Xs & Os Official Game Rules.

Section 8 Promotional Entries

Players may be able to enter eligible Powerball Xs & Os tickets through websites or mobile applications operated and maintained by third parties, including but not limited to MUSL or the Official Powerball® app (the "Powerball Xs & Os Promotion(s)"). Entries into Powerball Xs & Os Promotions will generally not be available through the player's KLC Fun Club Account or the KLC website, unless otherwise set forth in Individual Promotion Rules and Regulations for a promotion. All Promotional entries into any Powerball Xs & Os Promotions on the Official Powerball website or App are governed by the "Rules for the Powerball Xs & Os National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App." Players who enter tickets through the Official Powerball website or App agree to the Rules, terms of use, and privacy policies of the website and App. All matters and claims relating to promotional offerings for the Powerball Xs & Os game, including tickets, transactions, drawings, prizes and prize claims, are governed by Kentucky law and the official Rules for the Powerball Xs & Os National Promotions Program Offered on the Official Powerball® App. The Rules contain the sole and exclusive remedy for such claims.

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
