RULES AND REGULATIONS  
“KENTUCKY’S WIN PLACE SHOW”

---

1. CREATION

Pursuant to the laws creating and governing the Kentucky Lottery Corporation, there is hereby created a game, hereinafter called “Kentucky’s Win Place Show,” (or “Win Place Show”) which shall be conducted pursuant to these Rules and Regulations and KRS Chapter 154A. Tickets shall be made available for sale at the discretion of the President of the Kentucky Lottery Corporation and shall continue on sale until the President publicly announces a termination date.

2. GAME DESCRIPTION

Win Place Show determines winners from ticket holders matching: three (3) of three (3) of the Winning Numbers (the first three (3) horses) in **exact order/position**; three (3) of three (3) of the Winning Numbers (the first three (3) horses) in **any order/position**, but not exact order/position; or **any** two (2) of the three (3) Winning Numbers in **exact order/position**, with the three-digit Winning Numbers determined by the Official Results of a pre-selected future Featured Race. The numbers to be selected shall be between (1) and, depending upon the Featured Race selected, a minimum of four (4) and a maximum of twenty (20), with no repeating numbers and the possibility of one or more numbers being excluded as a result of Scratches. If less than four horses start a Featured Race, the race shall be deemed Cancelled and players will be entitled to a Replacement Ticket.

3. DEFINITIONS

- (a) **Lottery** – The Kentucky Lottery Corporation.
- (b) **President** – President of the Kentucky Lottery Corporation or any other person to whom the President’s authority is lawfully delegated.
- (c) **Quick Pick** – The selection of a Player’s numbers and position of the numbers by the Tote System.
- (d) **Featured Race** – A horse race with a minimum of four (4) horses and a maximum of twenty (20) horses conducted at a racetrack licensed according to the law of the jurisdiction of the racetrack, selected by the Lottery and its vendors, the Official Results of which serve as the basis for determining the Winning Numbers.
- (e) **Tote System** – The system, including hardware, software, communications equipment, and electronic devices that accepts and processes the transmission and cashing of wagers, calculates the odds and prices of the wagers, and records, displays wagering information for the Win Place Show Game. The availability of Win Place Show ticket sales and information is dependent on the availability of the Tote System.

- (f) **Standard Game Ticket or Ticket** – A Win Place Show ticket produced by a Retailer in an authorized manner, in which the Tote System generating the Ticket produces a Ticket containing three (3) randomly computer selected horses, identified by horse name, and the number of the horse; the name of the racetrack, the name or number of the race, the date, and post time for that Featured Race; the Ticket price; and the transaction serial number. Each Win Place Show two dollar (\$2.00) play will produce a separate Ticket.
- (g) **Replacement Ticket** – A Win Place Show Ticket produced by a Retailer in an authorized manner in the event that a player’s Ticket for a Featured Race contains a horse that subsequently has Scratched, or in the event that the Featured Race has been cancelled or declared a no-contest according to the rules and regulations of the racetrack where the Featured Race is conducted, or in the event that a Featured Race starts with less than four (4) horses after the player has purchased a Ticket, as further defined in Section 9. Replacement Tickets are eligible for the next available Featured Race open at the time the Replacement Ticket is produced.
- (h) **Free Ticket** – Win Place Show Ticket that is awarded as a prize to a player who has a Ticket which matches any two (2) of the three (3) Winning Numbers in exact position, as further defined in Section 8.
- (i) **Winning Numbers** – Three (3) numbers (the numbers of the horses finishing in the top three of the Featured Race) determined by the Official Results of the Featured Race, except as set forth in section 10(g) herein, shall be used to determine which Win Place Show Tickets are winning tickets.
- (j) **Retailer** – A person or entity licensed by the Lottery to sell lottery tickets, and who has been approved and designated to sell Win Place Show tickets.
- (k) **Official Results** – The results of the Featured Race as determined in accordance with the rules and regulations of the racetrack where the Featured Race is won and the laws of the jurisdiction where the Featured Race is conducted. Once declared official, the Official Results of the racetrack shall be final and binding as to the determination of the Winning Numbers and prizes. A subsequent change in the order of finish or award of purse money shall not affect the Official Results. Official Results shall be posted on the official Win Place Show mobile application (“Win Place Show App”) and at kylottery.com. Only Tickets with Winning Numbers as determined by the Official Results of the Featured Race shall be eligible for a prize, and the Official Results shall determine the prize payouts for each Featured Race. A player with a Ticket that contains three numbers of the horses finishing in the top three of the Featured Race as a result of a subsequent change in the order of finish or award after the Official Results shall not be eligible for a prize, and any players with a Ticket whose prize may have increased or decreased as a result of the subsequent change in the order of finish or award shall not be eligible for a different prize.

- (l) **Morning Line Odds** – The odds of a horse established in the racetrack program at the racetrack for the Featured Race before official betting takes place.

4. TICKET SALES RETAILERS

- (a) Win Place Show Ticket sales may only be made through such duly licensed Retailers as the President will designate.
- (b) The Lottery may, at its discretion, terminate sales, without prior notice, by any retailer upon the grounds set forth in the Retailer’s contract or license agreement (and any amendments thereto), in KRS Chapter 154A, and in any administrative regulations that may be adopted from time to time by the Lottery, copies of which may be obtained from the Lottery’s corporate headquarters upon written request.

5. TICKET PRICE

The wager amount for a Win Place Show Ticket is two dollars (\$2.00) per each Quick Pick play.

6. TICKET CHARACTERISTICS AND RESTRICTIONS

- (a) Win Place Show Tickets may be purchased from a terminal operated by a Retailer or a Retailer’s clerk by requesting the Retailer to manually produce a Win Place Show Ticket from the terminal. Win Place Show Tickets are not available to purchase with a play slip or through self-service machines.
- (b) All Win Place Show Tickets are “Quick Pick” tickets, each of which shall be produced by a licensed and authorized designated Retailer, whose lottery terminal shall produce a ticket upon which is printed the names and race numbers of three (3) horses, randomly selected by the Tote System, from the next available Featured Race. Winning tickets are determined by the order of the finish of the horses in the Featured Race.
- (c) A Ticket may not be cancelled at any time or for any reason.
- (d) A player may purchase up to twenty-five (25) Win Place Show Tickets in a single transaction from a Retailer terminal. Win Place Show Tickets are not available for the Multi-Draw or Play it Again features.
- (e) Information regarding the Featured Races, such as, Official Results, Winning Numbers, entry information, horse names, racetrack information or some sub-set thereof, shall be available through the Win Place Show mobile app (the Win Place Show App), and at other designated locations. The Win Place Show App ticket checker function provides information from the Tote System, and no information from the Lottery’s or its draw game vendor’s system is provided to the Win Place Show App.

- (f) The Lottery shall not be responsible for numbers or information reported in error on the Win Place Show App, the kylottery.com website, or any other medium or outlet.

7. TIME, PLACE AND MANNER OF THE FEATURED RACE AND WINNING NUMBERS

- (a) **Manner of Determining Winning Numbers** – The Winning Numbers for each Win Place Show Featured Race shall be determined by the Official Results of the Featured Race. The Official Results of the Featured Race shall serve as a drawing for the winning numbers in a draw game. In the event of a discrepancy between the horse name and the horse number printed on a ticket, the horse number shall be determinative. The Lottery and its vendors shall select the Featured Races to be used to determine Winning Numbers.
- (b) **Time of Determining Winning Numbers** – The Win Place Show game will be based on one Featured Race per day, with the time of Featured Race to be determined by the Lottery with its vendors. There will be no Featured Race on December 24 and December 25, or any day in which no race is available for selection. Tickets purchased on a day in which there is no available Featured Race will be placed in the pool for the next available Featured Race.

8. PRIZE POOL, PRIZES, AND DETERMINATION OF WINNING TICKETS

- (a) A player purchases a two dollar (\$2.00) Win Place Show ticket from a Retailer for the next available Featured Race from the time the pool opens until the pool closes for the Featured Race, as determined by Tote System (the “Featured Race Period”). All funds generated by Ticket sales remain directly under the control of the Lottery. Fifty percent of each ticket purchase will be allocated by the Tote System to the “total prize pool” for the Featured Race. The Tote System will assemble all required information and will calculate the prizes for the Featured Race by pooling the wagers and then dividing the top prize and second prize pool(s) in equal shares per each prize pool to the winners of those prizes, as further described in these rules.
- (b) The assigned value of all Free Ticket prizes and Replacement Tickets is deducted from the sales amount used to calculate the total prize pool. After deducting the value of the Free Ticket and Replacement Ticket prizes, the prize pool is calculated and then divided into two (2) prize pools.

The two prize pools will be divided eighty percent (80%) to the Top Prize pool and twenty percent (20%) to the Second Prize pool. Any carry-over from the Top Prize pool from prior Featured Race Period(s) shall be added to the Top Prize pool, and any carry-over from the Second Prize pool from prior Featured Race Period(s) shall be added to the Second Prize pool as set forth in subsection (f).

- (c) Top Prize Pool: Match 3 of 3 in **Exact Order/Position**. Winnings from the Top Prize pool will be paid to players who match the Winning Numbers (all three (3) horses) in **exact order/position**. A player holding each Top Prize winning ticket will receive an equal share of the Top Prize pool, rounded down to the nearest

dollar. The remainder (Breakage) is forwarded to the next available race's top prize pool; however, if the sum of breakage from the Top Prize pool and the Second Prize pool is zero or a negative, no breakage will be added to the Top Prize pool. There is no set maximum Top Prize. Prizes may be more or less depending on the size of the top prize pool for the Featured Race.

- (d) Second Prize Pool: Match 3 of 3 in **Any Order/Position**, but not exact order. Winnings from the Second Prize pool will be paid to players who match the Winning Numbers (all three (3) horses), in **any order/position** among the first three, but not in the exact order. A player holding each Second Prize winning ticket will receive an equal share of the Second Prize pool, rounded down to the nearest dollar. The remainder (Breakage) is forwarded to the next available race's top prize pool; however, if the sum of the breakage from the Top Prize pool and the Second Prize pool is zero or a negative, no carry over will be added to the Top Prize pool. There is no set maximum Second Prize. Prizes may be more or less depending on size of the second prize pool for the Featured Race.
- (e) Free Ticket prize pool: Match any 2 of 3 in **Exact Order/Position**. At the time Official Results are posted, tickets that match **any** two (2) of the Winning Numbers in **exact order/position** are winners of a Free Ticket prize. For example: Horse numbers 1, 2, and 3 finish in the top three of a Featured Race. The Winning Numbers for the race shall be 1-2-3. Therefore, tickets with a combination of 1-2-X or 1-X-3, or X-2-3 in exact order, will qualify for a Free Ticket prize. The Free Ticket prize has no cash value for the player and cannot be exchanged or redeemed for cash. **In the event that the Featured Race starts with six (6) or less horses, Tickets for that Featured Race shall not be eligible for a Free Ticket prize.** A Free Ticket Prize must be redeemed within one hundred eighty (180) days of the date of the Featured Race printed on the Ticket. In the event sales of Win Place Show terminate prior to the 180 day redemption period for a Free Ticket Prize, the player shall be entitled to a two dollar (\$2.00) cash payment, which must be claimed within the 180 day redemption period.
- (f) No Winning Tickets
- (1) If no Win Place Show Ticket matches three (3) of three (3) of the Winning Numbers (the first three horses) in **exact order/position**, there will be no payout of the Top Prize for that Featured Race. All funds from the Top Prize pool will be forwarded to the next available race and added to that Featured Race's Top Prize pool. However, tickets are eligible for a Second Prize or Free Ticket prize if the tickets qualify for such prizes pursuant to Section 8.
- (2) If no Win Place Show Ticket matches three (3) of three (3) of the Winning Number (the first three horses) in **any order/position**, there will be no payout of the Second Prize for that day's Featured Race. All funds from the Second Prize pool will be forwarded to the next available race and will be added to that Featured Race's Second Prize pool. However, tickets are

eligible for a Free Ticket Prize if the tickets qualify for such prizes pursuant to Section 8.

- (3) If no Win Place Show ticket matches any two of the Winning Numbers in exact order/position, there will be no payment of the Free Ticket prizes for that day's Featured Race.
- (g) **Dead Heats:** A Dead Heat is a race in which two or more horses in a Featured Race finish at exactly the same time. In the event of a Dead Heat in the first, second, or third position of a Featured Race (i.e., horses tie for first, second, or third), for the purpose of determining the Winning Numbers, the horse finishing in the Dead Heat which had the lowest Morning Line Odds (i.e., the longer odds, or least favored horse) as determined by the racetrack will be considered to have finished in position ahead of the horse finishing in the Dead Heat with the higher Morning Line Odds (i.e. the shorter odds, or more favored horse). Should two or more horses finish in a Dead Heat with the same Morning Line Odds, this tie break will be determined by the horse with the least money in the final Win Pool at the racetrack of the Featured Race.

Examples:

**First Place Finish Dead Heat:** Horse numbers 1, 2, and 3 finish in the top three of a Featured Race. Horses 1 and 2 finish in a Dead Heat for first position. Horse 1 had 9-2 Morning Line Odds. Horse 2 had 30-1 Morning Line Odds. Horse 2 will be determined to have finished in first position and Horse 1 will be determined to have finished in second position. Therefore, the Winning Numbers for the Featured Race would be 2-1-3. Or, Horse numbers 1, 2, and 3 all finish in a Dead Heat for first position. Horse 1 had 9-2 Morning Line Odds. Horse 2 had 30-1 Morning Line Odds. Horse 3 had 15-1 Morning Line Odds. The Winning Numbers for the Featured Race would be 2-3-1.

**Second Place Finish Dead Heat:** Horse numbers 1, 2, and 3 finish in the top three of a Featured Race. Horses 2 and 3 finish in a Dead Heat for second position. Horse 2 had 9-2 Morning Line Odds. Horse 3 had 30-1 Morning Line Odds. Horse 3 will be determined to have finished in second position and Horse 2 will be determined to have finished in third position. Therefore, the Winning Numbers for the Featured Race would be 1-3-2.

**Third Place Finish Dead Heat:** Horse numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4 finish in the top three of a Featured Race. Horses 3 and 4 finish in a Dead Heat for third position. Horse 3 had 9-2 Morning Line Odds. Horse 4 had 30-1 Morning Line Odds. Horse 4 will be determined to have finished in third position and Horse 3 will be determined to have finished in fourth position. Therefore, the Winning Numbers for the Featured Race would be 1-2-4.

- (h) **Minimum Prize.** In the event that there are Top Prize winning Tickets and/or Second Prize winning Tickets, but the amount of funds available for paying either or both the Top Prize or the Second Prize, as calculated by the Tote System, is less



than one dollar (\$1.00), the prize will be rounded up to one dollar (\$1.00), and there shall be a minimum prize payout of one dollar (\$1.00) to Top Prize and/or Second Prize winners.

- (i) No prize will be paid until the results of the race are official and the Official Results are posted.
- (j) The holder of a winning Ticket may win only one Prize per wager in connection with Winning Numbers and shall be entitled only to the highest prize won by those numbers.

9. OFFICIAL RESULTS, SCRATCHES AND CANCELLATIONS

- (a) **Official Results of Featured Race** – The Official Results of the Featured Race, and the resulting payout, shall be determined in accordance with the rules and regulations of the racetrack and the laws of the jurisdiction where the Featured Race is conducted. The Lottery does not determine and has no ability to contest, challenge or alter the Official Results.
- (b) **Scratches** – A Scratch is the withdrawal of a horse entered for a Featured Race. Scratch shall also include the removal of a horse as a wagering option in a particular Featured Race, or the declaration of a horse as a non-starter. If a horse is Scratched from a Featured Race in accordance with the rules and regulations of the racetrack and the laws of the jurisdiction where the Featured Race is conducted, no further Tickets shall be issued for the Featured Race which include the number of the Scratched horse. If a Ticket has already been issued for the Featured Race which includes the Scratched Horse, the purchaser whose Ticket includes the Scratched horse shall be entitled to a Replacement Win Place Show game ticket. The Replacement Ticket must be redeemed within one hundred eighty (180) days of the date of the Featured Race printed on the Ticket. In the event the President terminates the sale of Win Place Show prior to the 180 day redemption period for a Replacement Ticket, the player shall be entitled to a two dollar (\$2.00) cash redemption, which must be claimed within the 180 day redemption period.
- (c) **Cancellation** – If a Featured Race is cancelled or declared a no-contest in accordance with the rules and regulations of the racetrack and jurisdiction where the Featured Race is conducted, or the Featured Race starts with less than four horses, the purchaser shall be entitled to a future Replacement Win Place Show ticket. The Replacement Ticket must be redeemed within one hundred eighty (180) days of the date of the Featured Race printed on the Ticket. In the event the President terminates the sale of Win Place Show prior to the 180 day redemption period for an Replacement Ticket, the player shall be entitled to a two dollar (\$2.00) cash redemption, which must be claimed within the 180 day redemption period.

10. DETERMINATION OF PRIZE WINNERS; PROBABILITY OF MATCHING WINNING NUMBERS

- (a) The following table sets forth the estimated probability of matching the Win Place Show Winning Numbers with Featured Race fields of between 4 and 20 horses, rounded to the nearest whole number:

- (b) The amount of the prizes awarded to the holders of winning Tickets will be dependent upon: (i) the number of Tickets purchased; (ii) the number of winning Tickets; (iii) the size of the field of the Featured Race; and (iv) any adjustments necessary under these Rules.
- (c) Promotional features activated and terminated at the discretion of the Lottery may enable the holder of a Win Place Show Ticket to qualify for promotional prizes.
- (d) The number of Prize Pools and the allocation of prize money among the Prize Pools may be changed at the discretion of the President, the Board of Directors, and the KLC's vendors. Such change shall be announced by public notice.

11. TICKET RESPONSIBILITY

- (a) A Win Place Show Ticket is deemed to be a bearer instrument until a name is affixed upon the Ticket in the designated area. At that time the Ticket is deemed to be owned for all purposes by the person(s) so named.
- (b) The Lottery shall not be responsible for lost or stolen Win Place Show Tickets.
- (c) The purchaser of the Win Place Show Ticket has the sole responsibility for checking the accuracy and condition of the data printed on the Ticket.
- (d) The Lottery shall not be responsible for Win Place Show Tickets redeemed in error by a player from a Retailer.
- (e) Players must present a valid Ticket to claim a prize in accordance with section 12.
- (f) Winners are determined solely by the Official Results of the applicable Featured Race. The Lottery shall not be responsible for numbers reported in error on the Win Place Show App, the kylottery.com website, or any other medium or outlet. A subsequent change in the order of finish or award of purse money shall not affect the Official Results.

12. TICKET VALIDATION REQUIREMENTS

- (a) **Valid Tickets** – In order to be deemed a valid Win Place Show Ticket, the apparent winning Ticket must be presented and all of the following conditions must be met:
  - (1) The validation serial number must be present in its entirety. The numbers printed on the Ticket must correspond to the Winning Numbers for the Featured Race selected on the Ticket. The validation serial number and the selected numbers must both correspond to the computer validation records maintained by the Lottery or its designated vendor.
  - (2) The Ticket must be intact.

- (3) The Ticket must not be mutilated, altered, reconstituted or tampered with in any manner.
  - (4) The Ticket must not be counterfeit or an exact duplicate of another winning Ticket.
  - (5) The Ticket must have been issued by the Lottery through a Retailer in an authorized manner.
  - (6) The Ticket must not have been stolen.
  - (7) The Ticket must be validated in accordance with section 13 (relating to procedures for claiming and payment of prizes) and submitted for payment or, if a Free Ticket Prize or Replacement Ticket, redeemed within one hundred eighty (180) days of the date of the Featured Race printed on the Ticket.
  - (8) The selected numbers on the Ticket must be generated randomly by the Tote System.
  - (9) The Ticket data must have been recorded on the central computer system prior to the Featured Race and the ticket data must match this computer data in every respect.
  - (10) The randomly selected numbers, the validation data, the wager amount and the Featured Race of an apparent winning Ticket must appear on the official file of winning tickets and a Ticket with that exact data must not have been previously paid.
  - (11) The Ticket must not be misregistered, defectively printed or printed or produced in error to an extent that it cannot be processed by the Lottery.
  - (12) The Ticket must pass all other confidential security checks of the Lottery.
  - (13) By submitting a Win Place Show Ticket for validation, the player agrees to abide by the Rules and Regulations of Win Place Show, as determined by the President.
  - (14) There must not be any other breach of these Rules and Regulations in relation to the Ticket which, in the opinion of the President, justifies disqualification.
- (b) **Invalid or Defective Tickets** – Any Ticket not passing all of the validation criteria in this subsection shall be considered void and shall not be paid.
- (1) The determination of the President with regard to invalid or defective Tickets shall be final and binding. At the President’s discretion, an invalid

Ticket may be replaced with a ticket of equivalent sales price from any current Lottery game.

- (2) In the event a defective Ticket is purchased or in the event the President determines to adjust an error, the sole and exclusive remedy shall be the replacement of such defective and erroneous Ticket with a ticket of an equivalent sales price from any current Lottery game.
- (3) In the event a Ticket is not paid by the Lottery and a dispute occurs as to whether the Ticket is a winning Ticket, the Lottery may, at its option, replace the Ticket as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection. This shall be the sole and exclusive remedy for the holder of the Ticket.

13. PROCEDURES FOR CLAIMING AND PAYMENT OF PRIZES WON ON TICKETS PURCHASED FROM DESIGNATED RETAILERS

- (a) Prizes won shall be claimed within one hundred and eighty (180) days following the date of the Featured Race in which the prize was won, and such prizes shall be claimed in the same manner as draw game prizes as set forth below.
- (b) Tickets having a total cash prize value up to Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) may be claimed within one hundred and eighty (180) days following the date of the Drawing in which the prize was won and may be claimed by:
  - (i) presenting the Ticket at any Retailer, provided that such Retailer has sufficient funds available for payment, or at any authorized KLC Cashing Agent;
  - (ii) presenting the Ticket at the Lexington Regional Office;
  - (iii) presenting the Ticket at Lottery headquarters located at 1011 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40202; or
  - (iv) mailing the signed winning Ticket and an official Lottery claim form to: Kentucky Lottery Corporation, Claims Dept. 100, Louisville, Kentucky 40287-0001.
- (c) Tickets having a total cash prize value of over Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and up to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000).
  - (i) Tickets having a total cash prize value of over Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and up to Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) may be claimed within one hundred and eighty days (180) days following the date of the Drawing in which the prize was won by presenting the Ticket at any Retailer location that is an authorized cashing agent or in any manner specified in subsection (b) (ii), (iii) or (iv) of this section.
- (d) Tickets having a total cash prize value of over Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) and

up to Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars (\$99,999) must be claimed at the Lexington Regional Office or the Lottery headquarters located at 1011 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky 40202. Designated cashing agents may be authorized to cash prizes up to \$25,000.00 within ninety (90) days following the date of the Drawing in which the prize was won; however, tickets having a total cash prize value over Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) not claimed within ninety (90) days must be claimed within one hundred eighty (180) days following the date of the Drawing in which the prize was won by presenting the Ticket in the manner specified in subsection (b) (ii), (iii) or (iv) of this section.

- (e) Tickets having a total cash prize value of over Ninety-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety-Nine Dollars (\$99,999) must be claimed at the Lottery headquarters located at 1011 West Main Street, Louisville, Kentucky.
- (g) The Kentucky Lottery Corporation reserves the right in its sole discretion to increase the total cash prize values that may be claimed at cashing agents or at the Lexington Regional Office. Players can contact the Lottery headquarters or a Lottery Retailer for current cashing limits.
- (h) The payment of prizes to persons under eighteen (18) years of age and to those persons who may die before receiving any or all of a particular prize shall be paid in accordance with KRS 154A.110 (relating to prizes payable after the death of a prize winner and payment to persons under eighteen (18) years of age), and rules promulgated with respect thereto.
- (i) The Lottery shall be discharged of any and all liability after payment of prizes as provided in KRS 154A.110(4) (relating to discharge of Lottery liability upon payment).

#### 14. UNCLAIMED PRIZE MONEY

All prize money on winning Win Place Show Tickets may be retained by the President for payment to the persons entitled thereto. In the event no claim or redemption is made within one hundred eighty (180) days of the date of the Featured Race printed on the Ticket, the prize money shall be deposited and paid out in accordance with KRS 154A.110(3), as may be amended from time to time.

#### 15. TAXES

- (a) Kentucky and federal withholding shall be withheld by the Lottery from prize payments in such amounts as may be required, in accordance with applicable provisions of state and federal law.

#### 16. PURCHASE AND PRIZE PAYMENT RESTRICTIONS

- (a) Lottery tickets may only be sold to persons eighteen (18) years of age or older.

- (b) No Win Place Show game Ticket shall be purchased and no prize paid to any of the following persons; any member of the Board of Directors, officers or employees of the Lottery; any vendors (as defined in KRS 154A.010), including the Developer, or related entities, or any member of the board of directors, officers, employees of, partners in, or owners of any vendors of entities related to the vendors; or any spouse, child, brother, sister, or parent residing as a member of the same household in the principal place of abode of any said person, or any person prohibited from purchasing a pari-mutuel ticket pursuant to 810 KAR 1:009(13) and 810 KAR 1:026(32)(5)(d)(6).

17. GOVERNING LAW

- (a) In purchasing a Ticket, the purchaser agrees to comply with and abide by applicable laws, all Lottery Rules and Regulations, instructions, conditions and final decisions of the President, and all procedures established by the President for conduct of the Win Place Show game.
- (b) All decisions made by the President, including the declaration of prizes and the payment thereof, in the interpretation of the Rules and Regulations shall be final and binding on all players and on every person making a claim in respect thereof.
- (c) All decisions regarding the Official Results of the Featured Race, and or any other activities related to the Featured Race, shall be made by the applicable racetrack and or governing authority, and their authorized agents. The Lottery shall not determine, or in any way participate in, the Official Results, and the Lottery shall have no liability for any actions or decisions regarding the Featured Race or the Official Results.
- (d) The Win Place Show Game in all respects shall be governed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.
- (e) In the event a Ticket is not paid by the Lottery and a dispute occurs as to whether the Ticket is a winning Ticket, the Lottery may, at its option, replace the Ticket with a ticket of an equivalent sales price from any current Lottery game. This shall be the sole and exclusive remedy for the holder of the Ticket.
